5. Poppyhill School of Recording reserves the right to cancellation of any course. In this event applicants will have the option of a full refund of fees paid or a place on an alternative course.
6. Any student whose behaviour is being disruptive and detrimental to the progress of other students on any course can at the school's discretion be expelled from the course without recourse to any refund or appeal.
